Membership Terms and Conditions.

By enrolling with West London & Slough Taekwondo (WLS Taekwondo) all students agree to the following membership terms and conditions.

1. All students must behave responsibly and conduct themselves in a safe and courteous manner while attending lessons. This includes arrival before and after the lesson.
2. Students and Parents/Guardians must be aware of and abide by their relevant codes of conduct. Copies of these are available on request.
3. Parents/guardians are to be aware that no supervision is offered for students before the start and after the end of a lesson. The lesson has not started until the Taekwondo Oath has been recited. The lesson has ended after the instructor dismisses the class.
4. No supervision is offered for students who leave the lesson for any reason.
5. Students must log their arrival for a lesson on the register provided.
6. If a student wishes to leave the lesson for any reason they must inform the instructor beforehand.
7. The parents/guardians of young children are advised to remain on site during the lesson. It is assumed that any parent/guardian not remaining on site during the lesson consents to their child leaving the lesson and making unsupervised visits to the nearest toilet.
8. It is the responsibility of the student or the parent/guardian of the student to inform the instructor of any physical injuries or disabilities that may affect the student during the lesson. This must be done prior to the start of the lesson.
9. By signing in to the class in the register prior to the lesson students are declaring their fitness to partake in the lesson. If any student is in doubt about their ability to train they should consult their doctor prior to training.
10. Students must not change clothing or eat in the training hall.
11. All contact details for the student including next of kin details must be kept up to date with WLS Taekwondo. WLS Taekwondo must be notified of any changes immediately.
12. If a lesson cannot commence for any reason then WLS Taekwondo will endeavour to inform all students prior to that lesson. It is not guaranteed that an alternative to the cancelled lesson will be offered.
13. Training fees reflect and include discounts to allow for short breaks in training at Easter, during the summer school holidays and Christmas. These breaks will normally be no longer than two weeks.
14. No training will take place on public holidays.
15. Membership fees are non refundable.
16. New memberships are subject to a six month minimum period from the date of enrolment. New members must maintain direct debit payments for a minimum of six months from the date of enrolment. Failure to do so may result in extra charges being applied to your account.
17. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure all training fees and any other costs are paid in full when due. Failure to do so may result in extra charges being applied to your account.
18. Membership can only be cancelled in writing. A minimum period of one months notice will apply. This one months notice can be given before, but will only commence, after any minimum membership period has passed.
19. Membership will be deemed to be active until cancelled in writing. No refund of membership fees will be offered for non attendance of lessons.
20. Family and dual membership discounts apply to immediate family members only. Immediate family members are deemed to include; parents, couples, children of parents or siblings in one family.
21. WLS Taekwondo reserves the right to refuse new applications for membership or cancel existing memberships at any time.
22. If paying by direct debit, please note that WLS Taekwondo has appointed the BACS Approved Direct Debit Bureau, Eazy Collect Services Limited (www.eazycollect.co.uk), to collect your payments and **Eazy Collect** will be shown on your bank statement.
23. A credit agreement will be set up for all new membership applications. This credit agreement will be regulated by the Consumer Credit Act 1974. This membership application form is the Pre Contract Information Document.
24. Students are invited to attend gradings at the discretion of WLS Taekwondo. Students successfully achieving promotion during a grading will be awarded a new belt and certificate.
25. WLS Taekwondo reserves the right to remove/alter any discount schemes or promotions.
26. Any sparring equipment used for training must be purchased from WLS Taekwondo.
